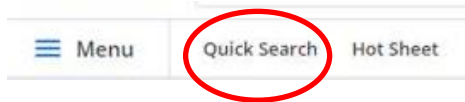
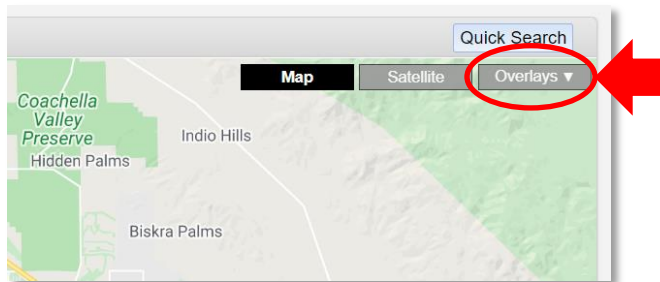


FIND THE NAME OF A SUBDIVISION

1. Start in “Quick Search”

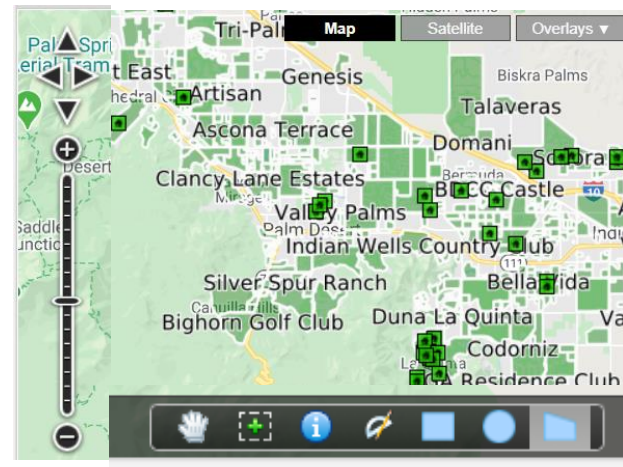


2. Within The Map Side of Quick Search Page Click the drop down arrow of the “Overlays” button



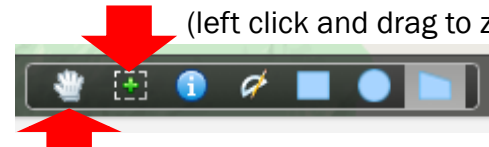
3. Click “Subdivision” from within the list

4. All subdivisions are displayed on the map



5. Zoom in an area with the “zoom tool”

(left click and drag to zoom in on an area)



6. Select “hand tool” to move the map around

(left click on your mouse and move the map around)
