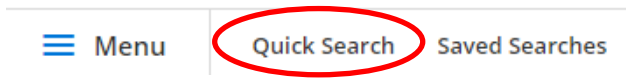


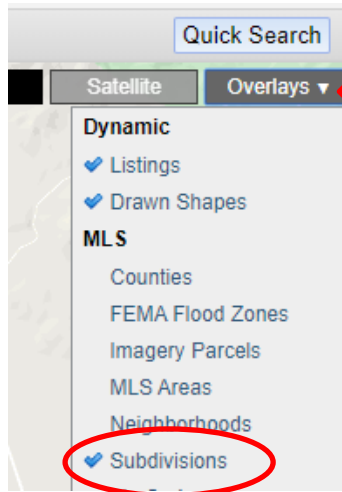
MAP A SPECIFIC AREA FOR A SEARCH

How to Navigate Within the Map

- 1) Start a quick search.



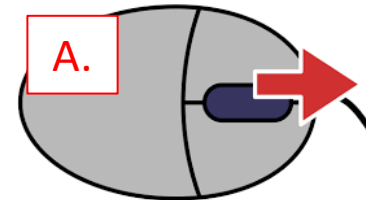
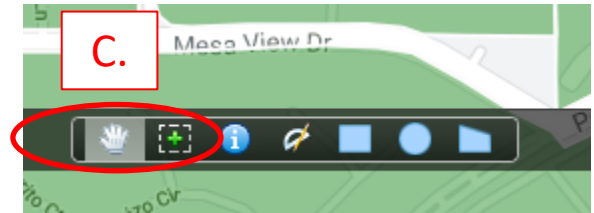
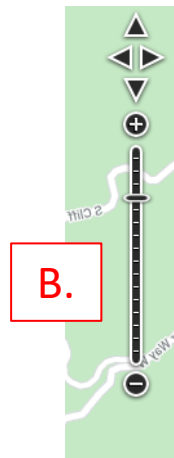
- 2) To find an area that is not mapped in a subdivision. Select “Subdivisions” from the “Overlays” dropdown menu.



2. Find the overlays button in the top righthand corner of the map window within quick search.

- 3) Zoom into the map to find an area that you want to search. There are different ways to zoom in and out.

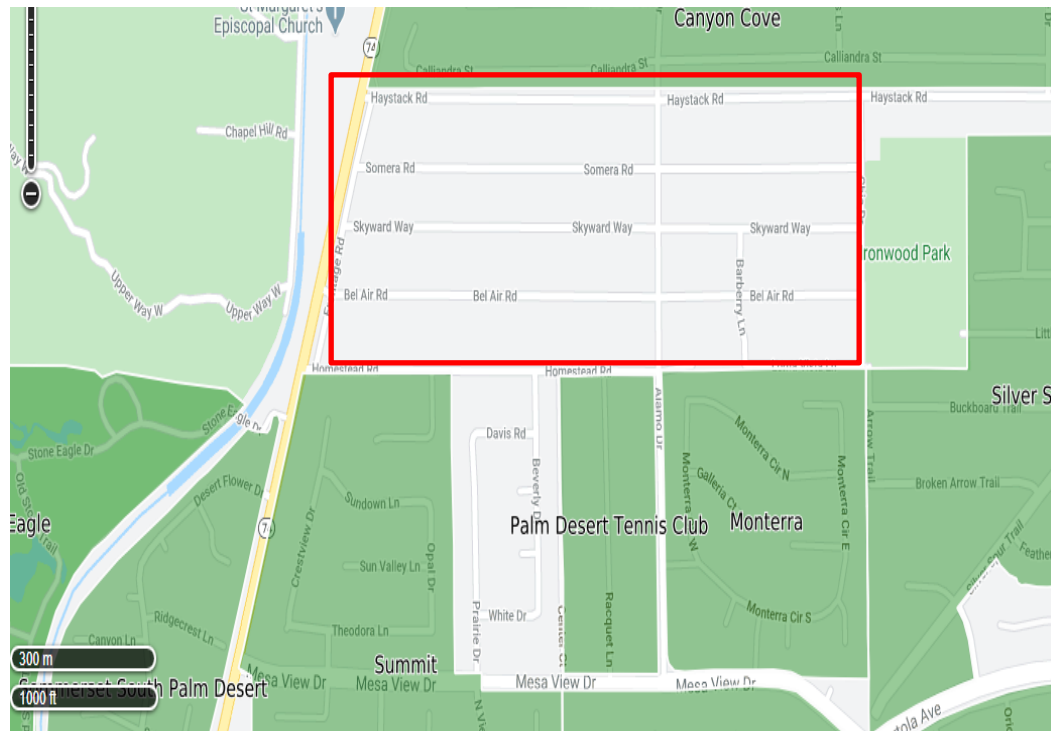
- A. Use the scroll wheel on your mouse.
- B. Use the zoom slide bar within the map.
- C. The hand tool allows you to move the map around. It is selected by default. Click and hold on the map and move it around.
- D. Use the + and - sign on your keyboard



MAP A SPECIFIC AREA FOR A SEARCH

LOCATE THE AREA WITHIN THE MAP THAT YOU WANT TO SEARCH

You can zoom to any area that you would like to use for a search. We are going to search in the red outlined area for this example. This is a small area along Hwy 74 south of Hwy 111.

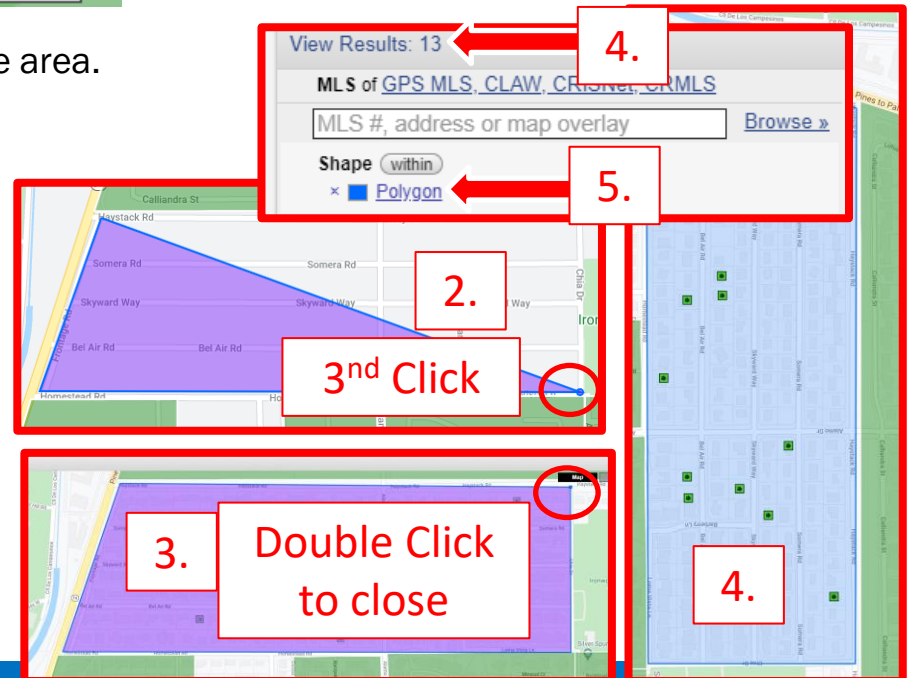
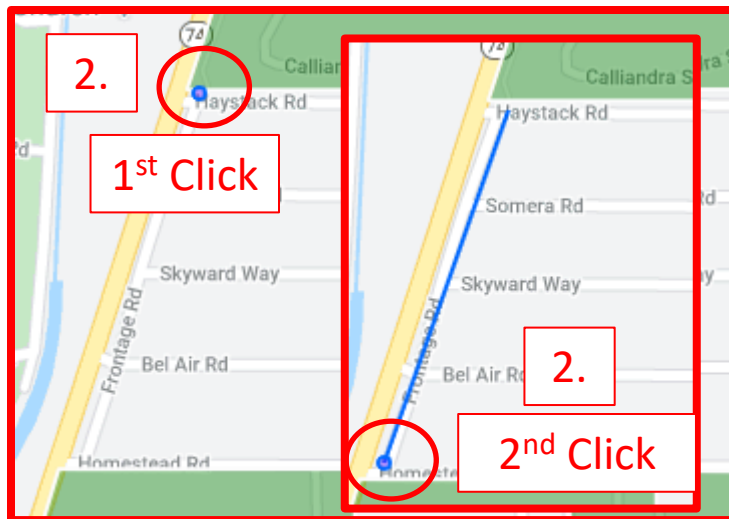


MAP A SPECIFIC AREA FOR A SEARCH

- 1) Click on the polygon tool to draw around the area. The tools are in the bottom of your map window.
- 4) You now have search results (13 results) within the polygon shape you created. You can save this shape as a map overlay to use in future searches.
- 5) The polygon shape is represented in your search criteria as a blue square.



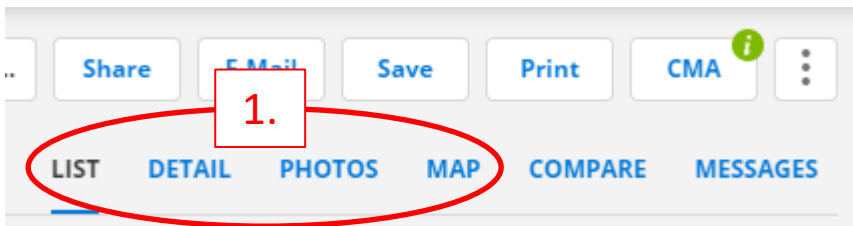
- 2) Click at each point around the perimeter of the area.
- 3) Double click to close the shape.

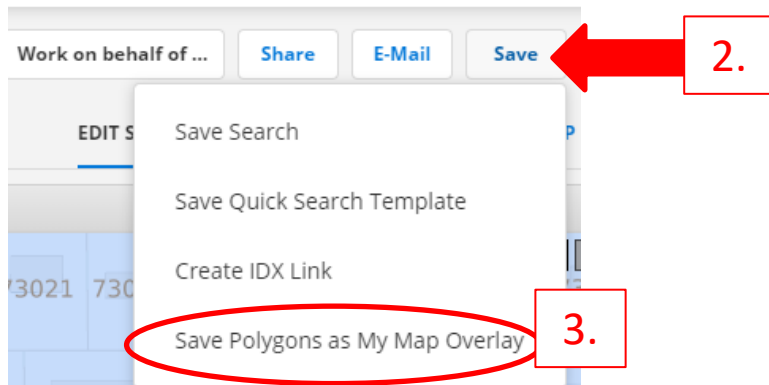
Save the Map Overlay to use in Future Searches

1) View your results.

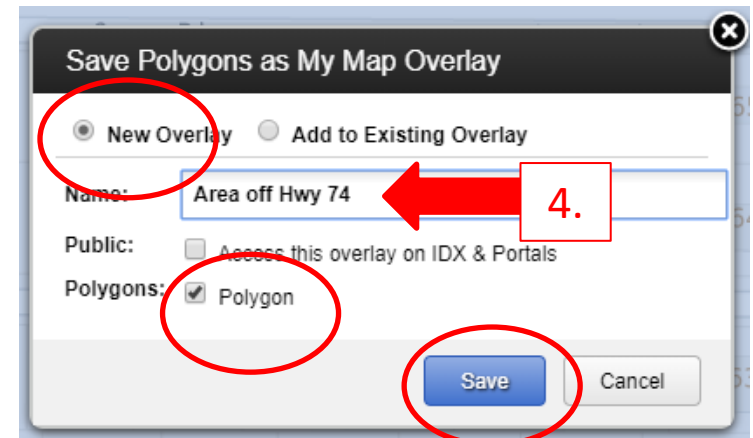


2) Click Save.

3) Select "Save Polygons as My Map Overlay."




4) Name your map overlay and click save.



MAP A SPECIFIC AREA FOR A SEARCH

How to Use Your Saved “My Map Overlay” in a New Search

- 1) Start a new Quick Search.
- 2) Click “Browse” next to the geo-coded search bar for a list of your saved map overlays.
- 3) Click on the map overlay to select it.
- 4) Double-click the word Polygon to add it to your search.
- 5) Or you can type the name of your saved map overlay in the geo-coded search bar.
- 6) Within the pop-out under the “My Map Overlays” heading double click on your saved overlay. It has now been added to a search.


